KUHS – Academic – Nursing – Provisional Affiliation to KMCT College of Nursing , Kozhikode for the seat enhancement of B.Sc Nursing programme from 90 to 125 for the academic year 2025–26 – Granted- subject to ratification by the Governing Council – Orders issued.

ORDER

Based on an interim order of the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) NO. 12662 OF 2024 (G) dated March 26, 2024, which directed the University to permit Kunhitharuvai Memorial Charitable Trust to upload an application for seat enhancement without insisting on a Government No Objection Certificate (NOC), the Principal of KMCT College of Nursing, Kozhikode, initially submitted an application for the enhancement of the B.Sc. Nursing Programme seats from 90 to 150 for the academic year 2024-25, vide paper read (1) above.

2.Later, after obtaining the NOC for 125 seats vide paper read (2), the Principal, vide paper read (3) above, requested that their application be considered and that the enhancement of seats from 90 to 125 be granted for the academic year 2025-26.

3.The University subsequently conducted an inspection to verify the available facilities for the proposed enhancement. Upon verification of the inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee pointed out deficiencies related to faculty, infrastructure, library staff, total number of staff nurses, and budget allocation, which were communicated to the College.

4.The Principal then submitted a compliance report vide paper read (4) above. Upon verification of the compliance report, the Scrutiny Committee recommended a re-inspection to ascertain the rectification of the deficiencies. This recommendation was placed before the Sub-Committee of the Governing Council held on October 18, 2025, and the Sub-Committee, vide paper read (5) above, also recommended a re-inspection.

5.Accordingly, the University conducted a re-inspection at the College on October 23, 2025. After verifying the re-inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee reported that all deficiencies had been rectified and therefore recommended granting the requested seat enhancement to the College.

6.The College has submitted the approval of the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC) for 125 seats for 2025-26 vide paper read (6) above. However, suitability from the Indian Nursing Council (INC) is yet to be obtained by the College.

7.The entire matter was placed before the Sub-Committee of the Governing Council held on November 5, 2025, and the Sub-Committee, vide paper read (7) above, recommended granting provisional affiliation to KMCT College of Nursing,





Kozhikode, for the enhancement of B.Sc Nursing seats from 90 to 125, subject to INC suitability.

8.The College has remitted the following fee for seat enhancement:

Interest-Free Refundable Deposit: Rs. 4,63,400/- (e-Challan No. KUHSDREFDST9081300610937 dated 17.11.2025)

Provisional Affiliation Fee (with 18% GST): Rs. 2,73,760/- (e-Challan No. KUHSDFPAS8622000610912 dated 17.11.2025)

9.In these circumstances, considering that the admission process for the B.Sc Nursing programme for the academic year 2025–26 is going to end soon, sanction is hereby accorded to grant Provisional Affiliation to KMCT College of Nursing, Kozhikode, for the seat enhancement of the B.Sc Nursing programme from 90 to 125 for the academic year 2025–26, subject to INC suitability and ratification by the Governing Council.

The college shall strictly adhere to the general conditions detailed below:

i. The Colleges should admit students to the Management seats in accordance with the Government of Kerala's Seat Matrix, only after the issuance of the seat matrix from the Government of Kerala published for the academic year 2025-26. ii. The Institution should obtain INC suitability to conduct the programme during the academic year 2025-26. If the intake is reduced either by the INC or KNMC, the number of seats to which admission can be made shall be reduced accordingly. iii. Selection, admission, and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Government of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled. iv. In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for the prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent instances of ragging, appropriate action, including the withdrawal of affiliation of the College, will be initiated. v. Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2025-26. The college has to apply for the continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years, remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of the letter of approval from the concerned apex bodies. vi. The College should remit the annual administration fee (including GST) fixed for the UG course for the year 2025-26. vii. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University. viii. The college should collect fees from the students to be remitted to this University as follows:
